





Enrollment by Type





Key Takeaways:

- New students seem to have stable enrollment while returning students have dropped about 30% in a 5 year span.




Top 20 Programs by Student Characteristic






Annual Median Wages by Years after Graduation

Annual Median Wages by Years after Graduation




Graphic Design Enrollment by Student Type





Chef Training Enrollment by Student Type






Annual Median Wages by Years after Graduation






Student Race/Ethnicity in STEM Transfer: LA&Sci-Math&Sci/Sci



Age of Student in STEM Transfer: LA&Sci-Math&Sci/Sci








Gender by STEM Transfer: LAr&Sci-Math&Sci/Bio





Student Race/Ethnicity in STEM Transfer: LAr&Sci-Math&Sci/Bio






